ITINERARY:

DAY 1: Arrival at London:

Arrival at London Heathrow airport. Pickup and transfer to hotel. Rest day free for leisure activities. Overnight Stay.

Day 2: London City tour + London Eye + Thames Cruise-London

Breakfast at hotel

Pickup and proceed for London City Tour. Panoramic sightseeing of London's famous places like Marble Arch, Hyde Park, Buckingham Palace, Piccadilly Circus, Trafalgar Square, Big Ben.

London Eye - The London Eye, or the Millennium Wheel, is a cantilevered observation wheel on the South Bank of the River Thames in London. It is Europe's tallest cantilevered observation wheel, and is the most popular paid tourist attraction in



the United Kingdom with over 3 million visitors annually. It has made many appearances in popular culture.

The structure is 135 metres (443 ft) tall and the wheel has a diameter of 120 metres (394 ft). When it opened to the public in 2000 it was the world's tallest Ferris wheel.

Later enjoy Thames River Cruise. Drop back to hotel. Overnight stay.

Day 3: London- Madame Tussauds and Windsor Castle- London Breakfast at hotel

Pickup and proceed to Windsor Castle. Entrance to Windsor Castle.

Windsor Castle - Windsor Castle is the oldest and largest occupied castle in the world. It is open to visitors throughout the year. Founded by William the Conqueror in the 11th century, it has since been the home of 40 monarchs.

Later proceed to visit Madame Tussauds.

Madame Tussauds - Experience one of London's best loved attractions! Star in immersive experiences and get up close and personal with more than 150 lifelike figures of your favourite celebrities.

Drop back to hotel. Overnight stay.

Day 4: London – Manchester Stadium – Manchester

Breakfast at hotel.

Check-out from hotel. Proceed to Manchester.

Visit Manchester Stadium. Entrance to Manchester United Stadium for tour. Visit the Museum & Stadium Tour at Old Trafford and walk in the footsteps of greatness. The Stadium Tour follows a great route, so you'll see the players' tunnel, walk next to the world-famous pitch, and visit the dugouts, before getting the view from the Ability Platform. There will be plenty of time for pictures, too.

Proceed to hotel. Check-in at hotel. Overnight stay.

Day 5: Manchester – Windermere Boat Ride and Steam Train – Glasgow

Breakfast at hotel. Check-out from hotel and proceed to Lake District. Enjoy Boat Cruise and Steam Train at Lake Windermere. Later proceed to Glasgow. Check-in at hotel. Overnight stay.

Day 6: Glasgow - Edinburgh City tour, Edinburgh Castle - Glasgow Breakfast at hotel

Pickup and proceed for Panoramic sightseeing of famous places of Edinburgh like Royal Mile, Palace of Holyrood house, St. Giles Cathedral.

Later visit Edinburgh Castle. Standard entrance to Edinburgh Castle.

Edinburgh Castle - Edinburgh Castle is one of the most exciting historic sites in Western Europe. Set in the heart of Scotland's dynamic capital city, it is sure to capture your imagination. The scenery will take your breath away.



Drop back to hotel in Glasgow. Overnight stay.

Day 7: Glasgow to Inverness via Highlands

Breakfast at hotel.

Check-out and proceed to Inverness via beautiful Highlands. View Scenery and pass-through small places.

Arrival at Inverness. Check-in at hotel. Overnight stay.

Day 8: Inverness - Inverness Tour, Loch Ness Cruise – Inverness Breakfast at hotel

Proceed for Panoramic sightseeing of Inverness.

Later proceed to enjoy Loch Ness Boat Cruise. Ticket for Standard Boat Cruise at Loch Ness.

Loch Ness - Loch Ness is a large freshwater loch in the Scottish Highlands extending for approximately 37 kilometres (23 miles) southwest of Inverness. It takes its name from the River Ness, which flows from the northern end. Loch Ness is best known for claimed sightings of the cryptozoological Loch Ness Monster, also known affectionately as "Nessie". It is one of a series of interconnected, murky bodies of water in Scotland; its water visibility is exceptionally low due to a high peat content in the surrounding soil. The southern end connects to Loch Oich by the River Oich and a section of the Caledonian Canal. The northern end connects to Loch Dochfour via the River Ness, which then ultimately leads to the North Sea via the Moray Firth.

Drop back at hotel Overnight stay.



Day 9: Inverness - Ben Nevis - Glenfinnan Viaduct – Glasgow

Breakfast at hotel.

Check-out from hotel and proceed to Ben Nevis. Enjoy Cable Car ride at Ben Nevis (subject to weather and operation condition). The Nevis Range Mountain Gondola is the only one of its kind in Britain and reaches the heights of 650m. It was built on the north face of Aonach Mòr, the 8th highest mountain in Britain,



originally as a way to transport skiers to the slopes. The Mountain Gondola has become an amazing visitor attraction, allowing visitors to enjoy the scenic ride and absorb the stunning views and clear mountain air.

Later proceed to Glenfinnan. Photo stop at Glenfinnan Viaduct which was featured in Harry Potter movie.

Later proceed to Glasgow. Check-in at hotel. Overnight stay.

Day 10: Glasgow - Loch Lomond and Whiskey Distillery Tour, Glasgow City tour- Glasgow Breakfast at hotel

Visit Glengoyne Whiskey Distillery. Our Distillery Ambassadors will take you on the unhurried journey our spirit makes – through the mashtun and washbacks to the swan-necks of our copper pot stills. Discover what makes the 'Glengoyne Way' so unique and why for every minute other whiskies spend in their stills, our spends three. Proceed to Loch Lomond. Enjoy Boat ride at Loch Lomond. Loch Lomond's South basin enjoys views of the magnificent Ben Lomond and passes a number of Loch Lomond's stately homes and castles along the shoreline. Venture out towards Inchmurrin Island- the largest of Loch Lomond's 33 islands and home to the ancient remains of Lennox Castle, which in the 14th century sheltered a fugitive Robert the Bruce before he was to become King of Scotland.

Later proceed to Glasgow. Enjoy Panoramic sightseeing of famous places of Glasgow like Glasgow Cathedral, Science Centre, Botanic Garden, People's Palace.

Drop back to hotel. Overnight stay.

Breakfast at hotel. Check-out and private transfer to Glasgow airport for onward flight.
